2016 Deerassic Park/NWTF Disability Archery Hunt

The National Whitetail Deer Education Foundation in partnership with the National Wild Turkey Federation Belmont County Limbhangers Chapter will be selecting 5 lucky participants to go on a guided archery deer hunt this year. Hunters will arrive Thursday, October 27th between 4 p.m. and 5 p.m. and hunt all day Friday October 28th and Saturday October 29th. The event will be headquartered at Deerassic Park and all hunts will take place on private properties in Southeastern Ohio; it will be a 100% wild, fair chase hunt. Applicants will be evaluated on their commitment to conservation and preservation of our hunting heritage. Submit a completed application for a chance to win a guided hunt with Deerassic Park Staff/Guides.

Instructions:

- 2. Make sure all portions of the application are complete and include all requested enclosures

Eligibility:

- 1. Applicants must be at least 12 years of age or older by October 27^{th} , 2016
- 2. Completed applications must be submitted by September 23rd, 2016
- 3. Applicants must have passed Hunters Ed. Course, and have held a previous license.
- 4. Copy of current or past hunting license must be included in application
- 5. Applicants must submit completed Application Information
- 6. Applicants must submit completed Questionnaire
- 7. Applicants must submit an essay or a 30-60 second video
- 8. Recommendation from family member or friend
- 9. Aide, friend or Family member must be able to attend

Selection Process:

- 5 applicants will be selected to join us for the hunt, Awardees will be notified by September 30th, 2016
- 2. Applicants will submit the completed official Deerassic Park application, along with required attachments, to Deerassic Park 14250 Cadiz Rd. Cambridge, OH 43725 by **September 23rd**, 2016
- 3. Selection of participants will be determined by NWDEF staff and Board of Directors, and NWTF Belmont County Limbhangers Chapter

The following will be provided for the selected hunters:

- 1. Lodging (if needed) at Deerassic Park or local accessible hotel
- 2. Meals (Thursday Night, Friday and Saturday)
- 3. Hunting License and 1 (either sex) deer tag


