Deerassic Park will be holding our Annual Disability Archery Deer Hunt on October 23rd and 24th. Five lucky participants will be selected for a fully guided and all inclusive hunt on private property in Southeastern Ohio. Base camp will be at the Deerassic Park Education Center located in Cambridge, Ohio and lodging will be at Salt Fork State Park Lodge. Applicants must have some type of disability (we are not specific to what), be over the ages of 12 by the date of the hunt (October 23th), have passed a hunters education class or held a previous license (apprentice license can count), and have a parent or guardian available to attend the hunt (if they are under 18). We will supply all hunting equipment including blinds and bows. Applications are available at www.deerassic.com. All applications must be submitted by Thursday, October 1, 2020. Winners will be selected and notified by Friday, October 2nd by email. All hunters will be hunting in ground blinds along with landowners and 1 person of their choice. Please do not apply if you feel uncomfortable hunting in a blind with one of our guides. Good luck!

2020 Deerassic Park Disability Deer Hunt

The National Whitetail Deer Education Foundation will be selecting 5 lucky participants to go on a guided archery deer hunt this year. The hunters will arrive on Friday morning, October 23rd, and the hunt will be held Friday afternoon and then all day Saturday, October 24th 2020. The event will be headquartered at Deerassic Park and all hunts will take place on private properties in Southeastern Ohio; it will be a 100% wild, fair chase hunt. If you do not have a bow (crossbow or compound), we will supply you with one for the hunt. Submit a completed application for a chance to win a guided hunt with Deerassic Park Staff/Guides. All hunters will hunt in a blind with a Deerassic guide and 1 other person of their choice (family member, etc.). If you do not feel comfortable hunting with one of our guides in a blind with you, please do not apply. Good luck.

Instructions:

Eligibility:

1. Applicants must have a disability (we are not specific to what kind of disability).
2. Applicants must be over the age of 12 years old by the date of the hunt (October 23, 2020). There is no age cap.
3. Completed applications must be submitted by **Thursday, October 1, 2020.**
4. Applicants must have passed Hunters Ed. Course or have held a previous license (apprentice license can count). A copy of current or past hunting license must be included in application
5. Applicants must submit completed Application Information and questionnaire.

Selection Process:

1. 5 applicants will be selected to join us for the disability hunt; Awardees will be notified by Friday, **October 2, 2020.**
2. Applicants must submit the completed official Deerassic Park application, along with required attachments, to mark@deerassic.com or by mail at Deerassic Park 14250 Cadiz Rd. Cambridge, OH 43725 by **October 1, 2020.**
3. Selection of participants will be determined by Deerassic staff and Board of Directors.

The following will be provided for the selected hunters:

1. Lodging (if needed) – Check-in on Friday, October 23rd and Check-out on Sunday, October 24th.
2. Meals (Friday night, and Saturday)
3. Hunting License and 1 deer either sex tag
4. Each hunter will receive a Deerassic Ultimate Hunters Package!
